WHEREAS, Lt. S. Gus Alexander, Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. S. Gus Alexander, Sr., and husband of Kathleen Alexander, was cited for gallantry in action while serving with Company B of the 27th Infantry's First Battalion in Vietnam during the period of February 2, 1969 to April 12, 1969; and

WHEREAS, Lt. S. Gus Alexander, Jr., was awarded the Silver Star, the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart, the National Defense Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal, and Combat Infantryman's Badge; and


