

## Patrick Michael McEnroe

Patrick Michael McEnroe was born in Houston, Harris County, Texas on July 22, 1937. Patrick has been active in the Boy Scouts of America since the age of 9, including Sea Scouts. He earned Scouting's highest rank of Eagle which is only achieved by less than 4% of all Scouts. As a Sea Scout, he advanced to their highest level – the Silver Award. While a Scout, he had the opportunity to attend the Second National Scout Jamboree held in 1950 at Valley Forge, PA. On October 4, 1954, Patrick enlisted in the Naval Reserve and in 1955, he graduated with highest honors from Jefferson Davis High School. From High School, he went to Georgia Tech on a Co-op Program scholarship and then went to Emory University and graduated in 1960 majoring in Political Science and English Literature.



Patrick took his Navy basic training in San Diego, California. He was honorably discharged as an Electronics Technician and Radioman, 3rd Class Petty Officer (ETN3) on October 3, 1962. Patrick has also been in insurance related activities since 1955, earning the following professional designations: Chartered Property Casualty Underwriter (CPCU), Associate in Claims (AIC), Associate in Loss Control Management (ALCM), Associate in Risk Management (ARM), and Certified Professional Insurance Man (CPIM). Patrick continues to work as a General Lines Agent.

Patrick is a Trustee for Post 111 and is actively involved with The American Legion's Oratorical Program for high school students. He is also active in the North Texas Georgia Tech Alumni Club as Roll Call and Membership Committees Chairman and is co-founder and Life Member of the Chester W. Nimitz Squadron of the Admirals of the Third Texas Navy that he helped establish in 2005 and, where he serves as Personnel Officer. Patrick was commissioned as an Admiral of the Texas Navy on February 8, 1966 by Governor John Connally. Lastly, he is an active member of Cumann Seanchais Bhreifne, a County Cavan historical society in Ireland and is currently working on four families' genealogies. At this time, Patrick is taking a more leisurely path in life and is winding down some of his businesses and intends to no longer be active in securities, mortgage loans, and teaching.

Patrick lives with his wife of 16 years, Myrna, in Desoto, Texas and has a daughter, Amanda, and a son (by marriage), Lt. Col. Mark Fluker who is currently serving in the U.S. Air Force.
